Para 1.20	Group meetings were held in Spring and Autumn at St. Lawrence's Church Hall, York, with various speakers, subjects and excellent food and refreshments; also in February a Model Railway Show. In June, there had been a Group Visit to the Yorkshire Wolds Railway. Activities contributing to the Group's funds have included: - • Sales of donated books and magazines, volunteers' badges and buttons, bringing in a total of £564.01. • Sale of new books and DVDs, Moorsline binders and sales proceeds from Group Meetings, St. Crux and our Model Railway Exhibitions, bringing in a total of £1,689.58.

Group volunteers have participated in maintenance, repairs and renewals of the NYMR's permanent way, including oiling of fishplates along the whole of the line. We had funded new interpretation signs, as part of the Grosmont Station Trail Project. Group funds and volunteers' efforts have also been expended on repairs and overhauls to the Civil Engineer's wagon fleet and on-track machines, including starting to overhaul the Shark Ballast Plough Brake Van, part financed by YAG; also numerous other sundry parts,

At the Derwent Valley Light Railway, the extensive restoration and overhaul of our former War Department Drewry diesel shunter was
completed, with its return to working order, dedication and naming in July. Also a rebuild of our Wickham Trolley's elderly JAP engine and carburettor repairs were continuing.
